Jason Brand will send the following letter to the Worcester County Libertarian Party:

Having heard through the grapevine that Worcester county had disaffiliated itself from ULMA, I'm writing to inform you that the state committee has voted to revoke your charter, and that unless we hear otherwise over the next 2 weeks, per our bylaws you will officially no longer be an affiliate and we will be forming another one for that area. Applicable provision of bylaws below: "2. Any affiliate may withdraw from the party at any time. The party may disaffiliate any group by 2/3 vote at State Convention. The State Committee may not disaffiliate a group, though it may by 2/3 vote revoke the

charter of an affiliate that is defunct or that has identified itself as uninterested in continued affiliation, after announcing the intent to revoke charter with at least two weeks' notice.
